



## VARIATION RED VACQUEYRAS

The elegance of Grenache

A pure expression of nature.

Grown in a single terroir in the Vallon de l'Oligocène (a small valley named after the epoch it dates from), with low yields, the grapes are vinified carefully over many weeks to give thus cuvée the well-crafted style and elegance of fine Rhône Valley wines.



### GRAPE VARIETIES

Noble Grenache Noir is the backbone of all southern Côtes du Rhône reds. In a small plot of vines planted in 1946, fringed by pines that temper the Mistral's damaging gusts, old vines - head trained and spur pruned - frugally yield a few bunches from soils of marl and clay-rich sand.



### VINIFICATION

The uncrushed grapes are destemmed, and we let their native yeasts go to work. Light-touch interventions (infusion and short, gentle pumpovers) let the terroir and grapes fully express themselves.

The wine is aged in concrete vats for 18 months, then bottled in our underground aging cellars.




### FOOD PAIRING

## TERROIRS

MAP OF VACQUEYRAS TERROIRS

### MIOCENE MOLASSE AND MARL

- GEOLOGICAL EPOCH: Miocene
- SOILS: sandstone and marl

### LE PETIT VALLON DE L'OLIGOCÈNE & LE PIÈMONT DE BEAUREGARD

- GEOLOGICAL EPOCH: Oligocene
- SOILS: red marls, clay-rich sands, cornstone and colluvial scree

### LE CÔNE DE LA FONT DES PAPES

- GEOLOGICAL EPOCHS: Quarternary (450,000 to 130,000 years ago) for the Cone; Miocene for the molasse on which the Cone sits.
- SOILS: fine sands and clays

### LA GRANDE TERRASSE DES GARRIGUES

- GEOLOGICAL EPOCHS: the limestone pebbles and gravel date from the Quarternary (450,000 to 130,000 years ago) and sit on Miocene and Pliocene geological formations.
- SOILS: limestone pebbles and gravels, brown clays.
